On August 22, 2004 (Sunday), Victim Juan Munoz and his girlfriend were shot while sitting in their car at the Tam's Burgers located at the corner of Rosecrans Avenue and Central Avenue in the city of Compton. Victim Munoz died at the scene, but his girlfriend survived. Approximately 10 minutes prior to the shooting, Victim Munoz and his girlfriend had been involved in a verbal altercation at the "Food 4 Less" grocery store directly across the street from Tam's Burgers. Surveillance video at the "Food 4 Less" captured both of the above suspects inside the business during the verbal altercation. The surviving victim identified the male wearing the "60 T. COBB" baseball jersey (Suspect #1) as the shooter.

The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Homicide Bureau is asking for the public's assistance to identify the above two suspects. Informants can remain anonymous.
