INFORMATION WANTED



On June 26, 1983, the victim was found inside an abandoned trailer, located at 13707 Little Tujunga Canyon Drive, Crescenta Valley, CA, which had been set on fire. The victim, a female White, 16 to 20 years of age, with blond hair, and a small build, was burned beyond recognition.

A suspect was arrested and sentenced. He admitted he picked the victim up at Sepulveda and Ventura Boulevard sometime after 4:00 a.m. on the morning of the murder.

Los Angeles County Sheriff's Homicide Investigators are requesting anyone with information as to the identity of the victim, who was wearing the above gold metal chain with a small charm with 14K gold inscribed on it, to contact Sheriff's Homicide Bureau.
