

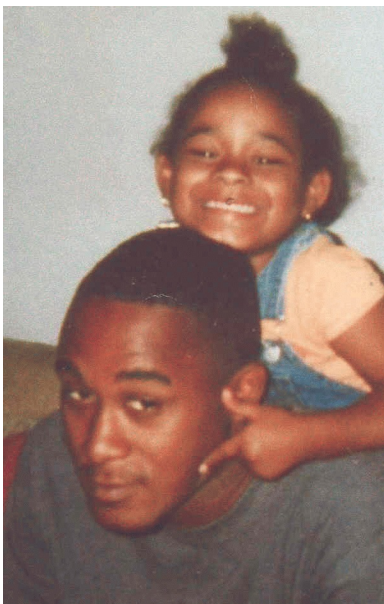

INFORMATION WANTED

MURDER INVESTIGATION - \$10,000 REWARD



On December 18, 2001, a week before Christmas, at approximately 9:15 p.m., Victim Cedric Hurd went to visit his 3-year-old daughter, when he was shot several times in front of his daughter's home, located in the 10900 block of Hobart Boulevard, Los Angeles (Vermont District).

The suspects are two male Blacks, 18-20 years old (now 23-25 years old), and were last seen eastbound on West 109th Place in a car similar to the one depicted above.

The Board of Supervisors has established a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder.

Sheriff's Detectives are seeking the public's assistance with any information regarding the suspects in this case. It has been over five years since the murder and Cedric's family wants answers.
